On 1<sup>st</sup> May 2021, we have celebrated Maharashtra Day & Labours Day.

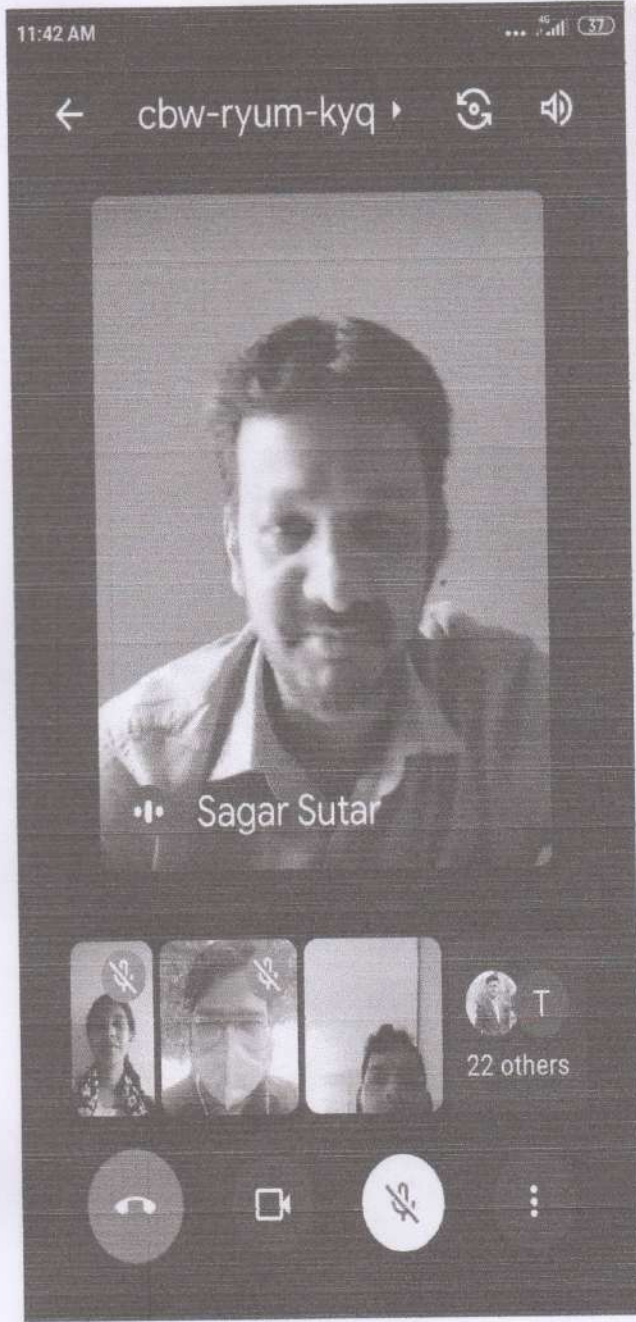
