

Key Policies:

- **Maharashtra State Candidature seats** : The candidates having the Maharashtra State Candidature as specified in sub-rule (1) of rule 5 of these rules, shall be eligible for these seats.
- **All India Candidature seats** : The candidates having All India Candidature as specified in sub-rule (2) of rule 5 of these rules shall be eligible for these seats.
- **Minority Quota seats** : The candidates having Minority Candidature mentioned in sub-rule (3) of rule 5 of these rules shall be eligible for these seats as specified in Schedule-I and Schedule-II. These seats shall be filled in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 6, of the Act
- **Institutional Quota seats** : The Institution can admit Eligible Candidate as specified in Schedule-I and Schedule –II, subject to following conditions. - (i) the Candidates having Candidature mentioned in sub-rules (1), (2), (3), (4) and (6) of rule 5 of these rules shall be eligible for these seats
- **TFWS Quota Seats** : These seats shall be filled in by the Competent Authority. These seats shall be available for admission to First Year of Engineering & Technology.
- **Supernumerary Seats** : Supernumerary Seats for the OCI or PIO, Foreign Students and the children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries Candidates.

Important Considerations:

- **Eligibility:** Candidates must meet the minimum eligibility criteria for the specific course and admission category.
- **Reservation Policies:** Reservations are applicable as per government guidelines.
- **Online Process:** Most of the admission process, including registration, option filling, and allotment, is conducted online.
- **Important Dates:** Candidates must carefully note the important dates and deadlines for each stage of the admission process.
- **Document Verification:** Ensure all documents are properly scanned and uploaded.
- **Communication:** Regularly check the official website, mobile app, SMS, and email for updates.

Admission Process:

1. **1. Registration:**
 - Candidates register online on the CET Cell website, submitting relevant details and documents.
2. **2. Merit List:**
 - A provisional merit list is published based on MHT-CET or other relevant entrance test scores.

 - Candidates online submit their college and course preferences in a prescribed format.
4. **4. Allotment:**
 - The CET Cell allots seats based on merit, preferences, and reservation policies.
5. **5. Document Verification:**
 - Allotted candidates need to verify their documents and confirm their admission by paying the fee.
