Key Policies:

- Maharashtra State Candidature seats: The candidates having the Maharashtra State Candidature as specified in sub-rule (1) of rule 5 of these rules, shall be eligible for these seats.
- All India Candidature seats: The candidates having All India Candidature as specified in subrule (2) of rule 5 of these rules shall be eligible for these seats.
- Minority Quota seats: The candidates having Minority Candidature mentioned in sub-rule (3) of rule 5 of these rules shall be eligible for these seats as specified in Schedule-I and Schedule-II. These seats shall be filled in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 6, of the Act
- Institutional Quota seats: The Institution can admit Eligible Candidate as specified in Schedule-I and Schedule –II, subject to following conditions. (i) the Candidates having Candidature mentioned in sub-rules (1), (2), (3), (4) and (6) of rule 5 of these rules shall be eligible for these seats
- **TFWS Quota Seats**: These seats shall be filled in by the Competent Authority. These seats shall be available for admission to First Year of Engineering & Technology.
- **Supernumerary Seats**: Supernumerary Seats for the OCI or PIO, Foreign Students and the children of Indian Workers in Gulf Countries Candidates.

Important Considerations:

- **Eligibility:** Candidates must meet the minimum eligibility criteria for the specific course and admission category.
- Reservation Policies: Reservations are applicable as per government guidelines.
- Online Process: Most of the admission process, including registration, option filling, and allotment, is conducted online.
- **Important Dates:** Candidates must carefully note the important dates and deadlines for each stage of the admission process.
- Document Verification: Ensure all documents are properly scanned and uploaded.

1. 1. Registration:

• Candidates online submit their college and course preferences in a prescribed format.

4. 4. Allotment:

• The CET Cell allots seats based on merit, preferences, and reservation policies.

5. **5. Document Verification:**

 Allotted candidates need to verify their documents and confirm their admission by paying the fee.
